

The Doyard Estate was built in 1927 by Maurice Doyard, who later was also a co-founder of the CIVC in 1941.

Both the Doyard and Mahé families have a long and illustrious history of grape-growing in the Premier Cru village of Vertus in the Côte des Blancs. The vineyards are planted to 90% Chardonnay and 10% Pinot Noir following the practice of *Agriculture Raisonée* since 1991.

This Champagne house is run entirely by ladies, with the dynamic Carole Doyard, the great granddaughter of Maurice, at the helm, with support from her mother Martine Doyard and her aunt Odile.
